Input sought on Grant widening

The city is seeking people who want a say on the Grant Road widening project, scheduled to begin in about four years.

The project is part of the Regional Transportation plan approved by voters a year ago. It calls for widening Grant Road to three lanes in each direction, with bike lanes and sidewalks, from Oracle Road to Swan Road.

The city is starting the planning process and is looking for 18 people who represent various community interests, including residents in the Grant Road corridor, business owners and neighborhood representatives.

The group is expected to meet about once a month for two to three years to work with city staffers and consultants planning some aspects of the corridor.
